Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of Minnesota Public Radio ("MPR"), this responds to the Commission's letter dated November 23, 2009, notifying MPR that the license for FM translator W215AI, Roseau, Minnesota, expired as of November 5, 2009, pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 312(g). As explained below, MPR restored W215AI to normal operations and provided notice to the FCC in advance of the deadline. Accordingly, MPR respectfully requests that the Commission rescind the November 23, 2009 letter and return W215AI to licensed status.

By letter dated October 29 and filed with the FCC on November 2, 2009 (copy attached), MPR intended to advise the Commission that the FM translator had resumed normal service on October 28, 2009. By separate letter filed the same day (copy attached), MPR also intended to advise the Commission that the translator's primary station had been changed to KQMN(FM), Thief River Falls, Minnesota.

The caption in each letter properly listed the station's Facility ID No. as 42942. However, due to an inadvertent typo, the translator's call sign was mistakenly identified as "K215AI" rather than W215AI. MPR apologies for the confusion.

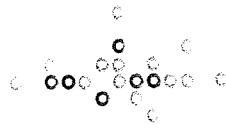
