On December 3, 2009, Minnesota Public Radio ("MPR"), licensee of FM translator K215AI, Roseau, MN, requested special temporary authority to operate this facility at reduced power owing to technical issues (file no. The purpose of this letter to inform the Commission that the technical issues have now been resolved and K215AI resumed normal operation at its authorized power on October 28, 2009.
