On August 27, 2003, 1400 Inc submitted an application with the Federal Communications Commission for authority to construct a new FM translator serving Hinckley, Minnesota. The station will operate on frequency 93.1 MHz with effective radiated power of .027 kW from a site approximately 5 km southeast of Hinckley, 0.6 km south-southeast of CR 15 and CR 129, and will rebroadcast the signal of WSCD, 92.9 MHz, Duluth, Minnesota.

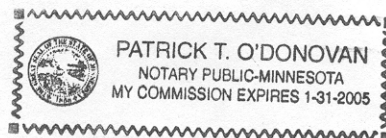
