Dear Chairs Garofolo and Olson,

The forty two signers of this letter are elected by our communities to assure that our children have access to outstanding public education. We do this so that all of Minnesota's children will have the capability to be successful, contributing members of our state.

The K-12 Education funding bill that was vetoed hurt our school districts' ability to educate children. It is that simple.

Key elements of the bill including reductions in special education funding and eliminating integration aid effectively cut funding for all districts in the state. The elimination of integration aid cuts millions in the next two years affecting three large school districts with uniquely needy student populations.

We fully understand the budget challenges facing the State of Minnesota. We applaud the legislature's stated goal to maintain funding for K-12 education and hold the children of Minnesota harmless when it comes to budget cutting. The bill before you does not succeed on either count.

By cutting integration aid and reducing funding for special education and de-linking compensatory aid, the budget effectively transfers funding from those who need more attention to those children who are already succeeding.

This will make it much more difficult to intervene and educate children with special needs, children from families in poverty and children of color. It will increase the achievement gap that the legislature aims to close.

As school board members, we ask you, the leadership of our state legislature, to find another way to maintain funding for the education of Minnesota's children. Balancing the budget on the backs of special education students, students in poverty and students of color will make it that much more difficult to close the achievement gap and that much more difficult to educate the people who will make Minnesota's future.
