The Court further finds that probable cause exists to believe that the above-described property and things are or will be at the above-described premises.

NOW, THEREFORE, YOU John MItterholzer of the Minnesota Department of Agriculture and any accompanying law enforcement officers or agency employees ARE HEREBY COMMANDED TO ENTER BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 7 A.M. AND 8 P.M. TO INSPECT THE ABOVE-DESCRIBED FOOD HANDLING OPERATION AS AUTHORIZED BY MINN. STAT. § 17.984 AND THE MINNESOTA FOOD LAW, TO SEARCH THE DESCRIBED PREMISES FOR THE ABOVE-DESCRIBED PROPERTY AND THINGS, TO SEIZE SAID PROEPRTY AND THINGS AND TO RETAIN THEM SUBJECT TO COURT ORDER AND ACCORDING TO LAW.

I, John Mitterholzer, apply under oath to this Court for a warrant to search the premises identified in this application for the property and things described in this application.

I know the contents of this application and supporting affidavit and believe they are true. I believe that all persons named in this application who provided information to me are reliable, and I believe the information they provided is true.

I have good reason to believe that the property and things described here:

- 1. Records that show the ownership, control, affiliation and operation of the farm operation of Alvin Schlangen and Alice Schlangen and/or other individual or entity under the direction or control of the aforementioned individuals;
- 2. Management records relating to the farm operation of Alvin Schlangen and Alice Schlangen and/or other individual or entity under the direction or control of the aforementioned individuals;
- 3. Records related to the unlawful sale of farm products by Alvin Schlangen and Alice Schlangen and/or other individual or entity under the direction or control of the aforementioned individuals;
- 4. Samples of farm products including but not limited to raw milk;
- 5. Samples of adulterated and/or misbranded food;
- 6. Food the sale or use of which is prohibited by law, or manufactured, sold, used, transported, offered for sale or transportation or had in possession with intent to use, sell, or transport in violation of any provision thereof;
- 7. Equipment, vehicles, and/or buildings used in the production and distribution of food the sale or use of which is prohibited by law, or manufactured, sold, used, transported, offered for sale or transportation or had in possession with intent to use, sell, or transport in violation of any provision thereof
- 8. Objects or other items which could be used to identify the perpetrator(s) and/or establish actual or constructive possession of the aforementioned items; and

I apply for issuance of a search warrant on these grounds:

- 1. The property described above was used to commit a crime.
- 2. The property described above constitutes evidence that tends to show a crime has been committed, or tends to show that a particular person has committed a crime.
- 3. The property described above represents a significant threat to public health.

The facts tending to establish the grounds for issuance of a search warrant are as follows:

On June 15, 2010, the Minnesota Department of Agriculture ("MDA"), with the City of Minneapolis, received certain information about Schlangen Family Farm ("SFF") during an inspection of Traditional Foods Warehouse, 302 W. 61st St, Minneapolis, MN 55419. MDA is charged with the duty to enforce Minnesota's food laws, including licensing, labeling, and sanitation requirements for food production. MDA is also charged with the duty to investigate to ensure a safe and healthy food supply in Minnesota. Schlangen Family Farm and its owners and operators hold no license or permit issued by the State of Minnesota to conduct any aspect of its food business.

Minnesota law permits only occasional, on-farm sales of unpasteurized or "raw" milk. See Minn. Stat. § 32.393. During the June 15, 2010 inspection, MDA observed milk offered for sale at TFW. Final test results revealed the presence of phosphatase in bottled "real" milk held for sale at TFW by Schlangen Family Farm. The presence of phosphatase indicates that the milk offered for off-farm sale in the twin cities was not pasteurized, in violation of Minn. Stat. § 32.393. Proponents of unpasteurized milk products often refer to such products as "real milk" products. Alvin Schlangen, Alice Schlangen, and Schlangen Family Farm offer "real milk" products for sale online and at TFW via off-farm distribution. See attached documents, including

notice to "Real Milk Customers," Schlangen Customer Order Forms, and notice re "Alvin's Eggs." Each sale of unpasteurized milk or milk products in violation of Minn. Stat. § 32.393 is a misdemeanor. In addition, SFF milk products observed at TFW were not labeled in conformance with Minnesota Food Law. SFF products that appeared to be offered for individual sale failed to indicate that the products were unpasteurized, failed to identify the producer or distributer, and failed to list ingredients. These labeling violations pose a threat to consumers.

In addition to the unlawful sale and distribution of unpasteurized milk and milk products, SFF and its owners and operators appear to be engaged in the resale of wholesale produce without a license as required by the Minnesota Food Law and Minn. Stat. § 28A.04. See attached Schlangen invoices of March 2010, indicating sale of "Snopac" brand fruit. Upon information and belief, SFF is neither a grower for nor a licensed wholesaler or retailer of Snopac products. I recently observed SFF offer for sale the product of another farm, "Whiskey Creek Farm" honey, at the Midtown Farmers Market.

SFF and its owners and operators appear to be engaged in the unlawful sale of meat as well. I observed the sale of meat to the general public, as evidenced in the attached photographs. Upon information and belief, neither SFF nor any of its owners or operators is part of any state or federal meat inspection program.

Wherefore, Affiant requests a search warrant be issued, commanding John Mitterholzer of the Minnesota Department of Agriculture and any accompanying law enforcement officers or agency employees to enter between the hours of 7 a.m. and 8 p.m., to inspect the above-described food handling operation as authorized by Minn. Stat. § 17.984 and the Minnesota Food law, to search the hereinbefore described premises for the described property and things, to seize said property and things for sampling and investigation, and to seize or embargo all adulterated and/or mislabeled product, and keep said property and things in custody until the same be dealt with according to law.


